## Press Release

Over the last several months construction vehicles and several passenger vehicles were been broken into and tools and other equipment were stolen from the vehicles. On 18 February 2014, officers from the Northwest Regional Police Department investigated the break-in of a construction van where various tools were stolen. Due to the recent thefts, officers from the Northwest Regional Police Department set up a surveillance detail watching a construction van.

On 20 February 2014, at 11:32 am, Officer Boutorabi observed a green Kia Rio sedan pull into the park and ride area of route 283 east bound at the Cloverleaf Road exit. Officer Boutorabi observed the driver, Everett Lee Pack, exit the vehicle and shatter two of the windows of the construction van. Lois Edna Pack also exited the vehicle to assist in the theft. Officer Boutorabi took Everett Lee Pack (W/M 37 yoa) and his mother Lois Edna Pack (W/F 76 yoa) into custody for breaking into the construction van and stealing items from the van. The investigation revealed Everett and Lois Pack were responsible for multiple vehicle break-ins, burglaries, and other thefts in Lancaster, Chester, Dauphin, and Berks County. Everett Pack and Lois Pack were incarcerated in Lancaster County Prison.
