

Please see below of the **NEW** ordinance for Mount Joy Township residents parking along the roadways during inclement weather. If your vehicle is in violation of this ordinance you could be issued a parking ticket and or your vehicle could be towed. Any questions please call station 367-8481.

In accordance with Ordinance 276-2011, the Municipal Traffic Engineer adopts the following changes to the traffic regulations in effect within Mount Joy Township:

- Schedule XVII. Winter parking: All of the existing traffic regulations are repealed and replaced with the following:

It shall be unlawful to park, or allow to be parked, any motor vehicle or other vehicle on any street within the Township following the accumulation of ice or snow of three inches or greater in depth until the snow has been completely plowed for the full width of the cartway. Within one hour after the commencement of each fall of snow in the Township, it shall be the duty of the owner, lessee or operator of any vehicle which has been parked upon any street or highway in the Township to remove said vehicle from the public streets or highways of the Township.

These provisions are adopted in accordance with 67 Pa. Code Chapter 212, §212.114(f)(1)(i) to facilitate the Township's maintenance operations (snow and ice removal). In accordance with Chapter 212, an engineering and traffic study is not required.

The Public Works crew shall post R7-203-2 "No Parking Until Snow is Removed" signs at locations where winter parking might otherwise occur so that drivers are aware of the restriction.
