In conjunction with Wolf Pack Graphix, the officers association will be offering a limited edition run of 50, 1:24 scale replica patrol cars, for \$25.00 a piece. The decals produced by Wolf Pack Graphix for the replica cars are made of the same material as the actual decals on the department’s patrol cars. These decals are then applied, by our officers, to 1:24 scale die cast replica 2014 Dodge Charger Police Cruisers. These are not a mass produced collectible, but a custom, very limited edition, hand made, collectible.

100 % of the proceeds of this sale will be used to support the various community initiatives that the Northwest Regional Police Officers Association supports on an annual basis. Some of these initiatives include:
