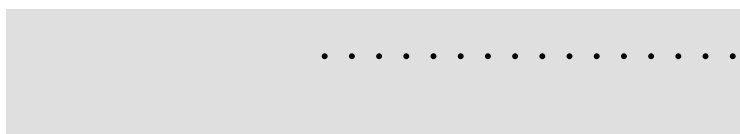
On 04 February 2015, at 7:03 am, officers from the Northwest Regional Police Department responded to a single vehicle accident on, Sr 283 west bound ½ mile east of the Elizabethtown Road overpass (Mount Joy Township). Officers arriving on the scene discovered a single vehicle accident with the driver being the only occupant. Information obtained by officers at the scene was the vehicle was traveling west bound on Sr 283 and went off the right side of the highway. The vehicle operator, Tyler James Shumate/19 yoa, of Elizabethtown was killed from injuries he sustained during the accident. On 04 February 2015, officers from the Northwest Regional Police Department responded to 319 Conoy Avenue, 433 Conoy Avenue, and 639 Buckingham Blvd (Mount Joy Township), for burglaries that occurred overnight.
