**Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the**  
**Northwest Regional Lancaster County Police Commission**  
**Held on July 28, 2026**

1. Kevin Baker called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. in the Mount Joy Township Municipal Building, 8853 Elizabethtown Road, Elizabethtown, PA 17022. Kevin Baker led the pledge of allegiance.
2. Roll Call: Present – William Weik, Rick Gible, Debra Dupler and Kevin Baker were in attendance. John Rudy was absent. Also present were Chief Michael Bryant and Lisa Heilner.
3. Public Comment: None
4. Consent Calendar:
  - a. Approval and ratification of the minutes of the May 26, 2026 meeting.
  - b. Accept and ratify the Treasurer's Report for the period of May 1 to June 30, 2026, subject to audit.
  - c. Approve payment of all bills via Bill List #11 through 16 in the amount of \$191,827.21; ratify payment of all payrolls for the period of May and June 2026 in the amount of \$405,444.82, which represents three (4) pay periods.
  - d. Raymond James Pension Account summary from May 1 to June 30, 2026

A motion was made by Debra Dupler, seconded by Bill Weik to approve items a. through d. of the Consent Calendar as presented. All members present voted in favor of the motion.

5. Old Business: None
6. New Business: Det. Brad Redinger was in attendance to discuss a software from Lexis Nexis called Accurint TraX Service. Det. Redinger has been using a trial version of the software and had the opportunity to use it in a fraud case he was investigating. Accurint TraX greatly expanded his ability to investigate this case. It gives access to cell phone locations and records. Det. Redinger and Chief Bryant both felt this would be a valuable asset to the Department. After some discussion, Debra Dupler made a motion, seconded by Bill Weik to purchase the Acurint TraX software for \$4950. All members present voted in favor of the motion.

Officer Dan Gordon, who handles the speed sign placement for the Department was also in attendance to provide information regarding the purchase of additional traffic calming devices (speed alert signs). The Department currently has one speed sign. Officer Gordon presented the Commission with two options for an additional sign(s). This would be beneficial because the signs could be placed in several different locations rather than just one at a time. After some discussion, Debra Dupler made a motion to purchase two Evolis Vision Radar speed signs from Elan City at a cost of approximately \$6899. Bill Weik seconded the motion. All members presented voted in favor of the motion.

Chief Bryant asked the Commission to consider the approval of an application for a COPS grant from the Department of Justice. This grant would be a matching grant which would provide funds towards the hiring of an additional police officer to increase our current compliment of officers. This would not be towards the hiring of the officer to fill the current opening that the Department currently has. The grant would be a flat amount up to \$125,000 distributed over three years. After some discussion, Debra Dupler made a motion, seconded by Rick Gible to approve applying for the COPS grant. All members present voted in favor of the motion.

Chief Bryant advised that he will again be advertising for the hiring of an officer and will be coordinating the timing with the next Lancaster County Consortium testing.

7. Advisements:
  - a. Detective Redinger completed his Police Phlebotomist recertification.
  - b. The Department has been hosting an intern from West Donegal Township who completed her sophomore year at Coastal Carolina University. She is majoring in Sociology and minoring in Criminology and Intelligence. Her career goal is to work for the FBI.
  - c. Sergeant McCoy and Officer Giberson completed a level 3 MCSAP certification in order to assist with the newly formed Lancaster County MCSAP Task Force.
  - d. Officer Good completed a Field Training Officer certification course.

- e. Officer Good received a Lancaster County DUI Top Gun award for his efforts in enforcing DUI laws in 2025.
- f. Detective Redinger completed a Use of Cellular Technology investigative course.
- g. Officer Gordon participated in the Tip a Cop for Special Olympics fundraiser. He also represented our department at a car show for Camp Cadet.
- h. Officer Bergmark assisted Manheim Borough Police at their Junior Police Academy by presenting a Drone demo.
- i. NWRPD participated in the Independence Day DUI enforcement wave funded by the Highway Safety Network.
- j. Officers Abby Bell and Solomon Myers attended a De-Escalation and Intervention Training hosted by our Department through Calibre Press.
- k. Officers Carl Bergmark and Danny Gordon were recognized by MESA for their efforts in helping save an individual who experienced cardiac arrest.
- l. The Department hosted a training for county law enforcement presented by Middle Creek Search and Rescue.
- m. The Department attended a Cones With A Cop event in Elizabethtown Borough at Rita's. We also hosted our own Cones With A Cop at Udder Bliss which was very well attended.

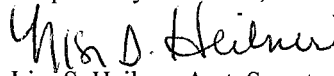
